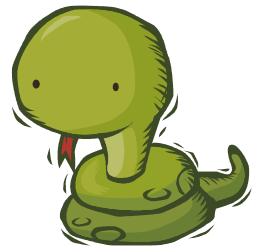

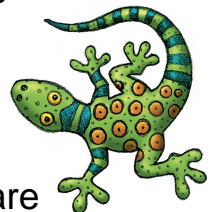


Primary Immune Deficiency Patient Meeting

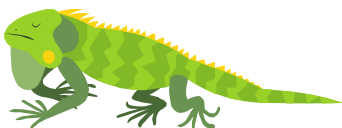
The meeting will provide attendees with the opportunity to:
